THIS CHANGES EVERYTHING

As the Ultrasound Technician here, I love that I get the opportunity to interact one-on-one with our patients. Whether it be one of the scariest days of their lives, or one of the happiest, I am grateful to be a part of it. I offer encouragement, love, and support to each of our patients. I am the first person to show them their baby -- pointing out its heartbeat, tiny arms and legs, and sudden movements. Patients are often shocked to see that so much is already formed, even at such an early age. Parents are not expecting to see a heartbeat. I've seen it thousands of times and it never gets old; the miracle of life is such a beautiful thing. I remember one patient in particular, we had seen recently. She was terrified when she first arrived, as this was an unexpected pregnancy and she wasn't sure if having a child was what she wanted in her life. She had just broken up with her boyfriend and was in her last semester of college. She was very quiet; I am sure thousands of thoughts were racing through her mind. Upon entering the exam room, she looked down at the ground, not making eye contact. I asked her the necessary medical history and then began the ultrasound. As I began pointing out on the screen her baby and its heartbeat, she got teary-eyed and began to show emotion. I asked, "How are you feeling?" she replied, "This changes everything."

We have since followed up with this patient, and she has determined to continue with her pregnancy. I believe up until the moment she had seen her baby on that ultrasound, abortion was a consideration. I am so thankful God brought her to us and we were able to provide the services she needed to choose life for her baby.

This is just one example of the many beautiful blessings that are happening at PCC! I look forward to many more throughout 2020.

Q: How would you describe your role at PCC?

A: I am a new volunteer patient advocate. I meet with our patients and try to better understand their needs and how we at PCC can help them best. It's a great opportunity to love and educate a woman, helping her to better understand her choices and giving her the dignity and respect to do so. It is truly an honor and privilege to walk with a woman during this often difficult and vulnerable moment of her life.

Q: What about PCC makes you excited?

A: I am especially thankful for the young and enthusiastic women working at PCC. They are beautiful ministers of God's love to our patients. And I love the

great respect and love given to everyone who walks in our door. This really is a Godly environment. The women who enter seem to appreciate that they are safe with us.

Q: What are you doing when you're not at work?

Q: What are you passionate about?
